Two work efforts that you may be interested in that are especially impactful are the 2D in Retail and the Modernisation of GTIN Management Mission Specific Work Groups (MSWGS). The 2D in Retail MSWG is working to align on and standardise future-state standards to enable global 2D barcode scanning in retail. The Modernisation of GTIN Management MSWG is working to make product identification simpler and more effective by building, adapting or clarifying standards to accommodate for: bundles, product variations, white label and refurbished products.

Global standards continue to move as quickly as the world around us. This is reflected in the fact that GSMP has the most active Mission Specific Work Groups operating for the 2nd quarter in a row. 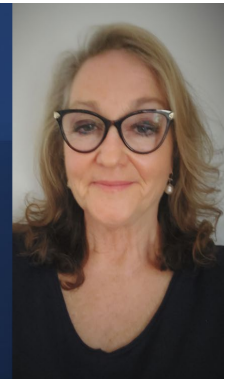
