- The GPC November 2022 publication is now published. 15 WR were included
- The SMG developed a revision of the GPC implementation guide, and will be ratified this month
- Worked with GS1 Egypt to form a work request for new bricks (over 100)
- A request was received to increase GPC publications from 2 to 4. Surveys were performed for community feedback. An answer will be available this month

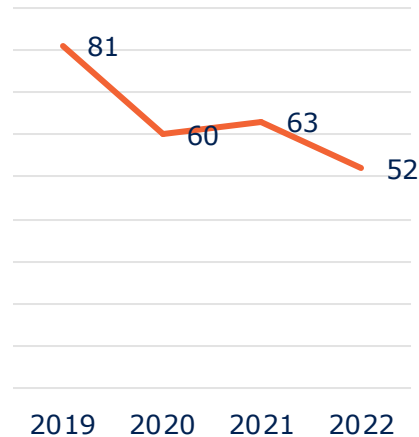
