Background:

To ensure that babies with special needs receive the most advanced care and attention, the former Department of Public Welfare established the Home for Disabled Babies on 14 November 1978. It began with approximately 50 babies and over time, has grown to support more than 500 children today.

The former Department of Public Welfare separated the disabled babies from the normal ones by establishing the Home for Disabled Babies on November 14, 1978.

It began with 30-50 babies and gradually, the facilities and buildings for disabled babies increased to support the ever-growing number of children needing the care.

There are more than 500 children today.

Objectives:

To take care of all boys and girls with all types of disabilities from birth to age of 7 years old.
