Business purpose

This group maintains the GS1 Global Product Classification system. This work group acts as a pool of experts for all GPC work groups and coordinates with associated Mission Specific work groups.

2025 year in review

- GPC May and November 2025 publications published.
- Completed work with GS1 US on U.S. government use of GPC in SNAP-related initiatives (e.g., Arkansas pilot).
- Updated GPC delta JSON and XLS Files to add a field for replacement code property.
- Completed work with IKEA to align GPC with their category assortment.
- GPC Implementation Guide update complete, with new sections on key GPC attributes rules.
- GPC Training delivered to GS1 Brazil and GS1 Denmark.
- Support provided to GS1 Denmark to upload their language into the GPC tool.


